

Dream Street 2020 Activity Instructions

Sunday, May 24

Dreaming of Dream Street

1. Color the front side to look like a rainbow with markers.
2. Flip it over and write your favorite thing about Dream Street.
3. Put 2 beads on every string and tie a knot on the bottom.
4. Tie the other side of the string to the holes at the bottom of the rainbow.
5. Tie last piece of string to both of the top holes.
6. Glue cotton balls on to the rainbow.
7. Let it dry!

Make a Treat with Dream Street

Activity 1: Aquariums

1. Take out 1 popart - use the back side.
2. Use a utensil (fork or other) to spread the icing onto the popart. Try to make it look like water!
3. Put a few goldfish on top of the icing!
4. Now you have your very own aquarium!

Activity 2: Rainbows

1. Take the other popart and spread icing all over it
2. Take the rainbow belt, and fold it so it looks like a rainbow
3. Place each side of the rainbow belt in the icing!

Activity 3: Oreo Spiders

1. Place 8 pretzel sticks into the icing of your oreo!
 - a. If you would like, you can put 8 more pretzel sticks in the other oreo.
2. Put two dots of icing at the top of the oreo.
3. Place one peppermint on each dot of icing to be the eyes!

Monday, May 25

One Bottle Pop

1. Cut a strip of construction paper that fits the bottle where the label should be.
2. Glue in place and let dry.
3. Write a letter to someone special.
4. Add the letter and any items you like to the inside of the bottle.
5. Decorate the bottle with stickers and color the paper on the outside.

Beary Fun with Abby Craig

Activity 1: Small Friends!

1. First, you will put glue in a spiral on the paper plate.
2. Next, place colored beads on the glue, making a spiral shape.
3. Cut a large heart shape out of your construction paper.
4. Glue the heart shape to the back of the paper, so that one half is not visible when looking at the side with the beads .
5. Finally, glue your googly eyes onto your paper.
Optional: draw a mouth :)

Activity 2: Bear Snacks!

1. First, you will shape the rice krispie treat into a circle.
2. Next, spread the icing all over the rice krispie treat.
3. Now, put your oreo in the center of the rice krispie treat.
4. Then put 4 peppermints in a semi circle around the oreo - these are the claws.
5. Enjoy!

Tuesday, May 26

Turtley Awesome Egg Carton Animals

Activity 1: Crab

1. Paint or color the egg carton whichever color you want your crab to be!
2. Take four pipe cleaners, of whichever color you choose, and bend them in half to make the back legs and use glue, tape, staple, or hot glue to stick them inside the egg carton.
3. Grab two more pipe cleaners for the claws, you will want to twist them towards the ends and curve them a little to make them look like claws!
4. Cut a pipe cleaner in half and glue on a googly eye to each end. Then you can either stick the pipe cleaner through the carton or you can use glue or another adhesive to attach the eye-pipe cleaners!

Activity 2: Turtle

1. Paint or color your egg carton the turtle color that is your favorite!
2. Attach the googly eyes to the puff ball-- this is going to be the head of the cutest turtle!
3. Once the carton is dried, add on shell details to your turtle, like little brown spots or squares to better resemble a turtle shell.
4. While those details on the shell drier, you can take a full or half pipe cleaners (cut in half), then fold the pipe cleaner in half for our turtle's feet! Then you'll want to attach those in the under side of the egg carton.
5. Lastly, you'll need to use some glue and attach the turtle's head to the egg carton!

Activity 3: Snail

1. Make sure you have small holes or half circles on each side of the carton.
2. Paint/color your egg carton whatever color you would like.

3. Get one full pipe cleaner and half of another.
4. Twist the half pipe cleaner towards the end of the full one so they are about the same length and attach/glue googly eyes to each of the ends of the pipe cleaners.
5. Lastly, make sure the egg carton is dry, you will place the googly eyes + the tail under the egg carton because all snails have a little tail :)

Wednesday, May 27

Whip Up Some Fun with Emma

Activity 1: Decorate Your Apron!

1. Use your markers and draw whatever you would like on your aprons!

Activity 2: The First Roll

1. Unwrap your rice krispie and place them on a flat surface such as a paper towel, plate, or clean counter.
2. Cut the rice krispie treat in half hamburger way and put one half aside. Then cut the other half in half again.
3. Place one swedish fish on top of each rectangle (there should be 2 pieces total).
4. Unwrap your fruit rollup and cut it into 2 thin pieces.
5. Wrap each piece of fruit roll up around the middle of each swedish fish and the rice krispie so that the swedish fish is secure.
6. It should look like this when you're finished and you should have 2 in total!

Activity 3: The Second Roll

1. Take the other half of the rice krispie treat and place it on a flat surface.
2. Cut it in half hot dog ways so you have 2 pieces.
3. Flatten the rice krispie treat piece using your hands.
4. Place a few gushers at one end of the rice krispie treat piece.
5. Starting with the end where the gushers are, roll up each rice krispie so that the gushers are secure on the inside.
6. Take the other fruit rollup and cut 2 thicker pieces (about 3 inches wide).
7. Wrap each piece around each of the rolls and stick the ends together.

Toilet Roll Crafts with Tovah

Activity 1: Dog

1. Paint the toilet paper roll.
2. Cut out the black paper to make ears - nearly full circles with one linear edge.
3. Glue the ears onto the toilet paper roll.
4. Color on eyes, mouth, and spots!

Activity 2: Octopus

1. Cut out whichever color construction paper to fit around the roll.
2. Cut 8 strips of construction paper.

3. Glue the paper around the roll.
4. Glue the 8 strips inside of the roll, so now you have tentacles!
5. Put on the two googly eyes.
6. Draw a smile!

Mad Fun Madlibs

1. Fill in a word according to the instructed blank! Don't read the story until you come up with your full list of words!
2. Once you complete your list, read the story! Fill in the blanks according to your list. You can repeat this with the second story.

Story 1:

1. Stick 4 pipe cleaners into the bottom of one of the half pool noodle rings.
2. Glue the eyes on top.
3. Yay jellyfish!

Activity 2: Pool Noodle Boats

1. Color or design the triangles--these are the boats' flags!

2. Then cut two small holes/slits on triangle-one on the top and one on the bottom.
3. Stick the straw through the two holes.
4. Then stick the straw with the flag into the pool noodle ring.
